Missions Focus: Doug & Rachel Jackson

Doug and Rachel are retired and moved to the state of Washington to be near their sons. Doug had a heart transplant a few years ago and is doing well. Rachel was able to set up a school mentoring program that has taken off this year with eight volunteers. The LifePoint Church adopted Mill Plains Elementary School and has been very supportive, providing books and games for the kids. **Pray** for this work.

Doug and Rachel, with their son Greg, traveled to Spain and Italy this summer. However, on return, Doug became very sick requiring hospital stay. It was determined his heart was good but that he had shingles. He was in a lot of pain and discomfort. He is now home, recovering strength and eating better.

Alfred, their Liberian "son", was in the states for studies and to gather materials and funds for a Christian school and camp in Tahn, Liberia. This was Rachel's dream when they were in Liberia. Although Rachel will not be able to go, she may do training videos for them. **Please pray** for this work and for wisdom. Alfred is also using the school facilities as a Bible School to train pastors. His mission is to train indigenous workers to do outreach and church planting. This was Doug and Rachel's vision when they were in Liberia.

Their spiritual Peruvian daughter, Millie, is graduating with her Masters next December and Rachel would like to go. However, Doug will not be able to go because his immune system is compromised, and the cardiologist advises against it. **Pray** for wisdom for this trip.
