1. Please join us for **Bring-Your-Own-Lunch Fellowship** immediately after morning service today!




2. **New Image** will be meeting on Thursday, January 18, at 10:30 am. If you're interested in coming, please sign-up in the back of the sanctuary.


Focus: New Year

Missions Focus: Long Island Youth Mentoring

John Cragg writes he is "amazed by the favor God is giving us". They have been around for 36 years and have a reputation but still God's favor is evident. He cites the following examples:

In the past few months, two school districts have come to them for help. There was a time when they couldn't get into a school without being thrown out. Now the schools call them! School representatives came to LIYM's new building and the details were worked out to starting homework clubs for the school. They will be held in a church in their district. They have also requested another site on the other side of their district. AMAZING!

A group home called saying they have six teenage boys, five of which want a mentor. They are working with a church to provide these mentors. LIYM will do the screening, training and supervision. However, this will be the church's outreach to the orphans. "What a wonderful way for a church to be obedient to God's call to care for the orphans"

LIYM still owe \$290,000 on the mortgage for the building and they are praying for the funds to come in so they can retire the mortgage. A friend, who is a financial planner, called and said he had a client who wanted to sell the stock that did so well in the upswing of the market but the taxes were too high; so he donated the stocks to LIYM, thus reducing their mortgage by \$51,000!

Please pray:

- For continued reduction of their mortgage.
- For these new homework clubs that had started.
- For mentors and their mentees, for a connection and ability to show them Jesus.
- For more mentors for the kids who are waiting for one.
